

BHA Regulations – Proposed Implementation Timeline

- New regulations will be effective July 1, 2015
- All accreditation-based programs must be accredited by October 1, 2016
- Existing ADAA and MHA community program regulations will be repealed December 31, 2016
- All programs will be required to have a license under the new BHA integrated regulations by January 1, 2017
- If an existing program applies for licensure by 10/1/16, and submits a current accreditation with the application, but BHA is unable to issue a new license prior to January 1, 2017, the existing certification or approval will be extended to the date of the issuance of a license.
