Dear Ms. Eisentrout:

On or about August 16, 2013 the Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists issued an **ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING** in the above cases. You were given an opportunity to attend a hearing to show cause why that suspension should not be continued. The hearing was scheduled to take place before the Board on September 20, 2013. Though properly notified, you failed to appear and thus, cause was not shown as to why the order of summary suspension should be lifted.

Consequently, the Board will not lift the summary suspension order. There would exist a substantial risk of serious harm to the public health, safety, or welfare in your continued practice. Furthermore, This letter is a public order of the Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists under Md. State Gov't Code Ann. § 10-617(h) (2) (vi).

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

Under the Board regulations, you have the right to request a full evidentiary hearing. This request will be granted if the Board receives a written request for the hearing within ten days of the date of this letter. The request should be sent to Tracey DeShields, Executive Director, at the Board's address. If you request such a hearing, one shall be provided within forty five days of the request, *see* COMAR 10.42.04.07G.
