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**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION AND
 REINSTATING PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT LICENSE**

On May 18, 2015, the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the “Board”) issued an Order of Suspension of License for Delinquent Child Support (“Order of Suspension”) against Anthony Anderson, Physical Therapist Assistant, License No. A1168 (the “Respondent”). The Board suspended the Respondent’s license to practice limited physical therapy in Maryland due to his delinquent child support payments upon two requests from the Baltimore City Office of the Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the “Administration”), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(e)(2)(i) (2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about May 19, 2015, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent’s license from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Physical Therapy Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 13-101 *et seq.*, the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a license.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(k), on this 20th day of May, 2015, by the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the license to practice limited physical therapy in Maryland held by Anthony Anderson, License No. A1168, is **LIFTED**; and it is further,

ORDERED that the license to practice physical therapy in Maryland held by Anthony Anderson, License No. A1168, is **REINSTATED** without additional restrictions or conditions; and it is further,

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions § 4-333(b).
