**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION**

On January 11, 2016, Richard S. Hageman, P.T., submitted a petition to the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the “Board”) requesting that the Board lift the suspension of his license, License No. 17767, initially set forth in a Consent Order dated November 17, 2015.<sup>1</sup> The Consent Order provides that Mr. Hageman may petition to lift the suspension after thirty (30) days, provided that he first submit to an evaluation with a Board-approved evaluator. The Board received a report from the evaluator on or about January 4, 2016, in which he recommended that Mr. Hageman be allowed to return to the practice of physical therapy and that “Mr. Hageman’s choice to pursue individual psychotherapy is elective on his part and is not necessary.” On January 19, 2016, the Board, satisfied that Mr. Hageman has complied with the terms of the Consent Order, voted to lift the suspension and place Ms. Brown on immediate probation with terms as set forth below.

**ORDER**

It is this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2016, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, hereby:

**ORDERED** that the suspension of Mr. Hageman’s license be lifted; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Mr. Hageman’s license be placed on immediate PROBATION for a minimum of TWO (2) YEARS, subject to the terms and conditions included in the Consent


Order as revised on December 15, 2015; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that after two (2) years of probation, Mr. Hageman may petition the Board to terminate probation, provided that he has been fully compliant with the terms of probation and does not have any pending complaints filed against him; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Mr. Hageman shall bear any and all expenses associated with this Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provision § 4-333(b).
