CONSENT AGREEMENT

Background

On May 31, 2005, Ms. Selwyn's license to practice limited physical therapy expired. Ms. Selwyn failed to submit a renewal application to the Board yet she continued to practice limited physical therapy until July 21, 2005, without a license. The Board subsequently decided to enter into this Consent Agreement in lieu of filing formal charges against Ms. Selwyn for the unauthorized practice of limited physical therapy.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ms. Selwyn's license expired on May 31, 2005.
2. The Board's records indicate that a renewal application was mailed to Ms. Selwyn on March 1, 2005.
2. Ms. Selwyn failed to submit a completed renewal application to the Board.
3. Although her license expired on May 31, 2005, Ms. Selwyn continued to practice limited physical therapy without a license until July 21, 2005.
4. Ms. Selwyn submitted a reinstatement application to the Board on July 25, 2005.
5. Ms. Selwyn only completed 14 of the 20 contact hours of continuing education required for renewal before the expiration of her license. Ms. Selwyn was permitted to complete the remaining 6 contact hours after the licensure expiration in order to enable Ms. Selwyn to reinstate her license. The 6 contact hours of continuing education completed after Ms. Selwyn's license expired may not be credited toward the 2005-2007 renewal period.
6. The Board reinstated Ms. Selwyn's license to practice limited physical therapy on July

25, 2005.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pamela Selwyn engaged in the unauthorized practice of limited physical therapy from June 1, 2005, to July 21, 2005, in violation of Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 13-401.

ORDER

Based on agreement of the parties, it is this ^{and 15th} ~~21st~~ day of Nov, 2005, by an affirmative vote of a quorum of the Board, hereby,

ORDERED that Ms. Selwyn shall pay a fine of \$200.00 within 60 days of the date of this Order; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Selwyn shall enroll in and successfully complete the Maryland Physical Therapy Law course within one (1) year of the date of this Order. This course may not be applied toward the 2 CEU's required for the 2007 renewal term; and be it further,

ORDERED that in the event that Ms. Selwyn fails to comply with the above conditions, the Board may, after providing Ms. Selwyn with notice and an opportunity for a hearing, take further disciplinary action against Ms. Selwyn's license including suspension or revocation.

ORDERED that this is formal disciplinary action of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Gov't § 10-617(h).
