**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION AND REINSTATING LICENSE WITH  
PROBATIONARY TERMS**

On March 6, 2014, Ms. Barron-Shasho (“Respondent”) submitted a petition to the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners (the “Board”) requesting that the Board lift the suspension of her license, License No. 08655, initially set forth in a Consent Order dated June 23, 2012. The Consent Order provides that Respondent may petition to lift the suspension upon successful completion of the first twenty months of suspension. Respondent has successfully completed the first twenty months of her suspension. On July 11, 2014, the Board voted to lift the suspension and place the Respondent’s license on immediate probation with terms as set forth below.

**ORDER**

It is this 11th day of July, 2014, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners, hereby:

**ORDERED** that the suspension of Ms. Barron-Shasho’s license be LIFTED; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Ms. Barron-Shasho’s license be placed on immediate PROBATION for at least FIVE (5) YEARS, during which:

1. Ms. Barron-Shasho shall submit to monthly supervision by a Board-approved

supervisor, ensure that such supervisor submit monthly progress reports to the Board, and comply with the recommendations of the supervisor; and

2. Ms. Barron-Shasho consents to the release of monthly progress reports to the Board by her treating therapist; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Ms. Barron-Shasho shall at all times cooperate with the Board in the monitoring, supervision, and investigation of her compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Ms. Barron-Shasho's failure to fully cooperate with the Board shall be deemed a violation of the probationary terms and a violation of this Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that in the event the Board finds in good faith that Mr. Barron-Shasho has violated any of the conditions of probation herein, or in the event the Board finds in good faith that Ms. Barron-Shasho has committed a violation of Title 19 of the Health Occupations Article or regulations adopted thereunder, the Board may take further disciplinary action against Ms. Barron-Shasho, provided that Ms. Barron-Shasho is given notice and an opportunity for a show-cause hearing; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Ms. Barron-Shasho shall bear any expenses associated with the Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).

3. I sign this Consent Order freely and voluntarily, after having had the opportunity to consult with counsel. I fully understand the language, meaning, and effect of this Consent Order.


