PRE – CHARGE CONSENT ORDER

Background

Ena May Watson was included in a Post Renewal Continuing Education Audit conducted by the Maryland Board of Social Examiners (“the Board”) on licenses requiring renewal by October 31, 2014. As a condition of continue licensure, licensed social workers are required to obtain forty (40) credit hours of Continuing Education Units (“CEU”) every two years in programs and categories approved by the Board, in accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 19-309(d)(3)(ii) and COMAR 10.42.06.03. The CEU's may all be in Category I but may not consist of more than twenty CEU's in Category II. A minimum of three CEU's, of the required forty CEU'S shall focus on ethics and professional conduct, including boundary issues.

In lieu of instituting formal proceedings against Ms. Watson for violations of the Maryland Social Workers Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 19-101 et seq., the Board voted to resolve this matter by way of a Pre-Charge Consent Order. As a result, the Board and Ms. Watson agreed to resolve this matter as set forth in this Consent Order.

FINDING OF FACT

1. At all times relevant hereto, Ms. Watson was licensed to practice social work in Maryland, License No. 05193. Ms. Watson was first licensed by the Board on July 19, 1986, and her license is set to expire on October 31, 2016.
2. All licensees are required to sign a statement on the renewal application attesting to having completed this requirement.
3. On January 7, 2015, Ms. Watson was mailed a letter from the Association of Social Work Boards ("ASWB") on behalf of the Board stating that she was randomly chosen as part of a Post Renewal Continuing Education Audit. This letter requested that Respondent supply continuing education documentation within thirty days of the letter. Ms. Watson responded to the audit; however, the documentation was not in compliance with continuing education requirements.
4. On February 4, 2015, Ms. Watson was mailed a second letter from ASWB. The second letter requested that Respondent supply continuing education documentation.
5. The audit revealed Ms. Watson completed 6 hours in Category I and zero hours in Category II Continuing Education Units. Therefore, 14 Category I units and 20 Category II Continuing Education Units were not completed. Ms. Watson failed the audit.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Ms. Watson is subject to disciplinary action in accordance with Md. Code Ann. Health Occ. § Health Occ. § 19-311 (4), (5), (6), (7), (13), and COMAR 10.42.06.03.

ORDER

Based on an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board, it is this 11th September day of 2015, hereby:

ORDERED that Ms. Watson's license shall be **REPRIMANDED**; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Watson shall pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.00, payable to the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners, within ninety days (90) of the date Order; and it be further,

ORDERED that failure to pay in full the above fine within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order shall be considered a violation of this Order, and after notice and opportunity for a show cause hearing shall subject Ms. Watson to further discipline such as suspension, revocation, or further fines based on the violations cited in this Order; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Watson will automatically be audited during the next two licensing renewal cycle.

Ordered that Ms. Watson complete the outstanding 14.0 Category 1 and 20 Category II CEUs identified in this audit within 180 days from the date of this letter. Submit copies of the CEU certificates to the Board by November 6, 2016 .

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
