**FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION OF LICENSE  
TO PRACTICE ASSOCIATE SOCIAL WORK**

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Board finds that:

1. At all times relevant herein, the Respondent was licensed to practice associate social work in the State of Maryland. The Respondent was initially issued a license to practice associate social work in the State of Maryland on or about February 6, 1998.

2. On or about January 3, 2005, the Respondent was charged in the District Court of Maryland for Wicomico County with one count of Possession of Child Pornography, in violation of Md. Crim. L. Code Ann. § 11-208 (a) (1) and (2) (a copy of the Statement of Charges and the Application for Statement of Charges, in *State of Maryland v Franklin Wright Wilson, Jr. Case No. 0H00034241*, are attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**).

3. On March 8, 2005, the Respondent plead guilty before Judge R. Scott Davis, in the District Court of Maryland for Wicomico County, to one (1) count of Possession of Child Pornography in violation of Md. Crim. L. Code Ann. § 11-208 (a) (1) and (2) (a copy of Defendant Trial Summary, in *State of Maryland v Franklin Wright*

*Wilson, Jr. Case No. OH00034241*, is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit B**).

4. Judge Davis found the Respondent guilty of one (1) count of Possession of Child Pornography, in violation of Md. Crim. L. Code Ann. § 11-208 (a) (1) and (2).

5. The Respondent received a six (6) months suspended sentence. The Respondent was placed on supervised probation for a period of three (3) years, ordered to undergo counseling, and pay court costs (a copy of the Probation/Supervision Docket and the Defendant Probation Summary, in *State of Maryland v Franklin Wright Wilson, Jr. Case No. OH00034241*, are attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit C**).

6. Possession of Child Pornography is a crime involving moral turpitude.

### **CONCLUSIONS**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that the Respondent is violation of H.O. § 17-311 (8).

### **ORDER**

**ORDERED**, that the License issued to Franklin Wright Wilson, Jr., to practice associate social work in the State of Maryland is hereby **REVOKED**; and it is further


**ORDERED**, that the Respondent is prohibited from practicing associate social work in the State of Maryland; and be it further

**ORDERED**, that the Respondent shall surrender to the State Board of Social Work Examiners the his wall and display certificates within five (5) days upon receipt of this Order; and be it further

**ORDERED** that for purposes of public disclosure and as permitted by Md. State Govt. Code Ann. § 10-617(h) (2004 Repl. Vol.), this document consists of the contents of the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order, and that the Board may also disclose to any national reporting bank or other to whom the Board is mandated to report; and be it further

**ORDERED**, that this Final Order is a public document pursuant to Md. State Govt. Code Ann. § 10-601 et seq. (2004 Repl. Vol.).
