FY2016 BRF GRANT FUNDING PRIORITY

Effective July 1, 2015, applicants will be prioritized as follows:

1. Failing OSDS in the Critical Areas
Primary residence – 100% (income based grant eligibility)
Secondary Residence – 50% (income based grant eligibility)
2. Failing OSDS outside the Critical Areas
Primary residence – 100% (income based grant eligibility)
Secondary Residence – 50% (income based grant eligibility)
3. Non-Conforming OSDS in the Critical Areas
Primary residence – 100% (income based grant eligibility)
Secondary Residence – 50% (income based grant eligibility)
4. Non-Conforming OSDS outside the Critical Areas
Primary residence – 100% (income based grant eligibility)
Secondary Residence – 50% (income based grant eligibility)
5. Other OSDS in the Critical Areas, *including new construction*
Primary residence – 100% (income based grant eligibility*)
Secondary Residence – 50% (income based grant eligibility)
6. Other OSDS outside the Critical Areas, *including new construction*
Primary residence – 100% (income based grant eligibility*)
Secondary Residence – 50% (income based grant eligibility)

Non-profit Entities 100% (including governmental entities)

For-profit Businesses and non-owner occupied properties used for rental or other purposes for a profit, not in an LLC, LLP, Corporation or other designated business entity – 50%

***While an applicant may be eligible for a 100% BRF Grant, the final grant award is determined by the priority, amount of grant funds disbursed to Caroline County and the demand for such funds. For instance, a Priority #5 and #6, new construction project, primary residence may be awarded a 50% BRF Grant.**
