Strong Interest

- 50 proposals
 - 25 Emergency room redirection proposals
 - 14 Mental Health/Substance Abuse Integration Proposals
 - 11 Addressing Other Concerns
- 21.9 million in requested funding
- Many good proposals, more than could be funded on this round

12 Successful Proposals

- Total funding 4.5 million dollars
 - Exceeding the Commission's initial target by a million dollars
- Types of proposals funded
 - 5 Emergency room redirection proposals
 - 5 Mental Health/Substance Abuse Integration Proposals
 - 2 Other initiatives

Successful Proposals

- Offered a diverse set of strategies for improving care
- Were geographically diverse
 - Urban, suburban and rural proposals were funded
- Planned significant expansions to vulnerable populations
- Had clear, achievable plans for sustainability beyond the grant period
- Showed strong commitment from partnering organizations
