AMENDMENT ORDER

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy is in receipt of a request to modify the Consent Order of Reinstatement of Valentine Nowak Jr. The request was discussed at the Board of Pharmacy Executive Meeting on November 17, 2004 and the following modifications have been agreed to:

ORDER

By an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, it is hereby,

ORDERED that Condition # 1 be modified to allow for a maximum work week of 50 hours on the Consent Order for Reinstatement dated November 24, 2003.

ORDERED that Condition #2 be deleted on that same order.

ORDERED that Condition #3 be modified to allow the respondent to work in a maximum of two different pharmacy locations provided the Board is notified of the employment arrangements.

ORDERED that Condition #11, requiring continuing therapy be deleted; and be it further,

ORDERED that all other conditions remain in place as is on the Consent Order for Reinstatement dated November 24, 2003.
