**Suspension for thirty days; Following termination of suspension, Probation for a minimum of one year with terms and conditions.** The Board found that the practitioner guilty of unprofessional conduct, failed to meet appropriate standards for the delivery of respiratory care, failed to practice under the supervision of a physician or in violation of a supervisory order of a supervising physician. The physician shall not prescribe CDS outside of those settings or for use outside of those settings. **Termination of nine month suspension. Probation for a minimum of 18 months with terms and conditions.** The Board determined that the physician complied with the conditions of the

Following termination of suspension, Probation for a minimum of three years with terms and conditions.** The Board determined that the physician is guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine and sells, prescribes, gives away, or administers drugs for illegal or illegitimate medical purposes. **Reprimand; Probation for one year with terms and conditions. The Board dismissed the charge of failure to keep adequate medical records. Date of Action: March 27, 2014

**Area of Practice: Family Medicine (Salisbury, MD)**

**Reprimand; Probation for a minimum of two years with terms and conditions. The physician shall permanently cease prescribing buprenorphine for any purpose. The physician shall permanently cease prescribing CDS for pain management purposes, however, the physician may prescribe CDS to a patient for acute pain, but with no more than a five day prescription of CDS. The physician may prescribe CDS to patients for non-pain management purposes.** The Board found that the physician is guilty of unprofessional

conduct, failed to meet the standards of quality medical care and failed to keep adequate medical records. Date of Action: March 14, 2014

**The Board's Final Decision and Order, issued on December 15, 2011 and the Board's Order Staying Suspension are Vacated.** The Court of Special Appeals vacated the judgment of the circuit court based solely upon an error concerning subpoenas. The case has been remanded to the Office of Administrative Hearings for further proceedings. Date of Action: March 18, 2014
