107	<p>Our company currently holds the IV&V Contract for the MMIS system per CATS II TORFP F50B0400031 (“IV&V Contract”) as noted in Question #75. We have requested withdrawal from the IV&V Contract from DoIT. We have never performed any work under the IV&V Contract, as an NTP was never issued. Assuming DoIT agrees to our withdrawal request under the IV&V Contract prior to the date proposals are due for this solicitation (which is expected before the MERP proposal due date) please confirm that DHMH would not disqualify a MERP proposal that includes us as a participating subcontractor, and that this former contract would not form the basis for a conflict of interest.</p>	<p>Vendors awarded services under the Department of Information Technology issued Task Order RFP # F50B0400031 for IV&V services will not be permitted to be proposed on PMSQMS OPASS #12-10806 proposals as the prime or subcontractor. DHMH would not disqualify a vendor proposal as long as the vendor is released from award from the IV&V services contract prior to performing any services under the IV&V contract by the time the original PMSQMS proposals are due.</p>
