


The Marriage paragraph on the Mother’s Tab has a direct impact on the Father’s Tab and the opening of the data fields for entry.

- In the Marriage paragraph, the tab key must be used to move from the “Ever married?” check box (through all of the fields) over to the Father’s tab. This allows the system to properly process the edits.
- The “Ever married?” must be answered appropriately.
- If either “Married at time of birth?” or “Declaring a father?” questions are checked the Father’s tab is open for data entry. If a box is not checked the Father’s information fields will not be open for entry.
- If the “Declaring a father?” box is checked, the date fields must be entered and must match. Refer to: **EVRs Supplement A AOP Processing** for details on the handling of the AOP.
- The Mother’s “Name prior to marriage Last” field will be open for entry when the “Ever married?” box is checked. This feature allows the entry of a maiden name for the Mother.
- When the Mother has never been married the “Ever married?” is not checked and the Mother’s last name from the Child’s Tab is carried over to the “Name prior to marriage Last” field.
