


Staying Healthy is Important

What is Primary Adult Care (PAC)?

PAC is a program that covers basic health services for lower-income adults in Maryland. PAC covers primary care doctor visits, hospital bills for emergency room visits, mental health services and substance abuse treatment for free. PAC also covers prescription drugs with a small co-pay.

Starting in 2014, people on PAC will receive full health insurance benefits, with even more services covered at no or low-cost.

Is PAC for me?

You may be eligible for PAC if you:

- are age 19 or older
- have a limited income (up to \$1,200/month)
- are not enrolled in Medicare
