RE: Surrender of Registration to Practice as a Registered Massage Practitioner  
Registration Number R03630

Dear Ms. Bodnarchuk:

I agree to voluntarily surrender my registration to practice as a registered massage practitioner (“RMP”) in the State of Maryland, registration number R03630, to the Maryland State Board of Massage Therapy Examiners (the “Board”). I understand that I may not practice as an RMP, with or without compensation, as it is defined in the Maryland Massage Therapy Act (the “Act”), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. (“HO”) § 6-101 *et seq.* and the Board’s regulations, COMAR 10.65.01 *et seq.* In other words, as of the effective date of this Letter of Surrender, I understand that I am in the same position as an individual who is not registered to practice as an RMP. I understand that this Letter of Surrender shall become a **PUBLIC** document and shall become effective on the date of the Board’s acceptance of this Letter of Surrender. I agree that this letter may be released or published by the Board as a final decision and order under the Public Information Act, Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.*

On or about July 22, 2023, the Board received information regarding an unlicensed individual assisting Board applicants take the Board’s jurisprudence examination. Specifically, based on the information provided, it was apparent that the unlicensed individual was in possession of approximately 75 questions taken directly from a Board jurisprudence examination. The Board conducted an investigation. During that investigation, I was interviewed by Board staff. During that interview, I admitted to receiving assistance from the unlicensed individual in taking the Board’s examination. In addition, I admitted to taking photographs of examination questions. It is now my understanding that the Board believes that it has sufficient information to charge my registration with violations of the Act, specifically HO § 6-308(a)(1) (“Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a registration or registration for the applicant or for another”) in that I accepted the unauthorized assistance and guidance during a Board licensing examination and attempted to pass it as my own work and research. I understand that, if this matter proceeded to an evidentiary hearing before the Board, there likely is sufficient evidence to find and conclude as a matter of law that I violated HO § 6-308(a)(1), and I understand that the Board could sanction my registration pursuant to the Act, which could include the revocation of my registration. Moreover, I have stated that I am no longer practicing massage therapy. Thus, it is my desire to surrender my registration to practice as an RMP at this time.

**LETTER OF SURRENDER**  
**Tierney Langley, R03630**

In executing this agreement to surrender my registration to practice as an RMP to the Board, I agree that I will not apply for reinstatement for a period of **THREE (3) YEARS** following the date of the Board's acceptance of this Letter of Surrender. I also agree that if, after a period of **THREE (3) YEARS**, I decide to apply for reinstatement as an RMP in Maryland, I will approach the Board in the same posture as an unlicensed individual whose registration has been revoked. In considering my application for reinstatement, the Board may review my entire Board file, including any information the Board receives after the execution of this letter. I understand that it will be my burden, as an applicant for reinstatement, to demonstrate that I meet all of the Board's requirements for reinstatement of my registration at the time I submit a reinstatement application. I understand that if the Board reinstates my registration, it will be reinstated through the Board's disciplinary process and that my registration will only be reinstated by the Board's issuance of a public order of reinstatement and that the Board may, in its discretion, place my reinstated registration on probation subject to terms and conditions.

I acknowledge that upon the execution of this Letter of Surrender, I shall surrender to the Board any indicia of Maryland registration that is in my possession, including my Maryland registration to practice massage therapy, number R03630, and any wall certificate. I understand that the Board will advise the National Practitioner Data Bank of this Letter of Surrender, and in any response to an inquiry, that I have surrendered my registration in lieu of potential disciplinary action under the Act that the Board may institute. I also understand that in the event I should apply for licensure in any form in any other state or jurisdiction, this Letter of Surrender, and all underlying documents, may be released or published by the Board to the same extent as a final order that would result from disciplinary action pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Prov. §§ 4-101 *et seq.*

I wish to make it clear that I have voluntarily, knowingly, and freely chosen to submit this Letter of Surrender. I understand that, by executing this Letter of Surrender, I am waiving the right, now and in the future to any evidentiary hearing at which I would have the right to counsel, to confront witnesses, to give testimony, to call witnesses on my own behalf, to contest the facts summarized in the second paragraph of this Letter of Surrender and at which I would have the right to all other substantive and procedural protections provided by law, including the right to appeal.



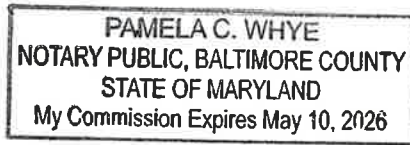


