

MEDICAL DAY CARE SERVICES WAIVER PROGRAM

The Medical Day Care Services Waiver offers qualified Medicaid participant services in a community-based day care center. Day care centers operate five to seven days a week. This waiver is administered by the Maryland Department of Health.

Medical Day Care Services:

- Skilled nursing and nursing assessments
- Medication monitoring
- Meals
- Social work services
- Activity programs
- Daily living skills training
- Transportation
- Therapy
- Personal care
- Nutrition services

Services are provided by licensed medical day care providers. Licensing standards are found in COMAR 10.12.04, Day Care for Elderly and Adults with a Medical Disability. Copies of the COMAR regulations may be obtained through the Maryland Division of State Documents at www.dsd.state.md.us

WHAT IS MEDICAL DAY CARE?

Medical Day Care is a structured group program that seeks to maximize health functioning and independence of eligible Medicaid participants by providing community-based health, social and related support services, as an alternative to institutional care.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Technical Eligibility:

- Individuals must be at least 16 years old.
- Individuals must not be enrolled in another home and community-based waiver.

Financial Eligibility:

- Individuals must qualify for Medicaid in the community.

Medical Eligibility:

- Individuals must meet the level of care required for nursing facility services.

Medical day care is also an available service under the following home and community-based waiver programs - Brain Injury Waiver, Community Options Waiver, Community Pathways Waiver, Community Supports Waiver, Family Supports Waiver, and Model Waiver.
