## ORDER VACATING ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION

On December 12, 2012, the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") issued an Order for Summary Suspension against the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician held by Navced Afridi, Registration No. T09087. At Mr. Afridi's request, the Board held a Show Cause hearing on June 5, 2013, at which Mr. Afridi was given the opportunity to show cause why the summary suspension should not be continued. Mr. Afridi appeared at the Show Cause hearing on his own behalf; the State was represented by Administrative Prosecutor Roberta Gill. Both parties were given the opportunity to present oral argument.

Upon consideration of the arguments presented at the June 5, 2013 Show Cause hearing, the Board believes that Mr. Afridi's practice as a pharmacy technician poses no immediate threat to the public health, safety, or welfare. Accordingly, the Board concludes that the summary suspension imposed on December 12, 2012, should be terminated.

## **ORDER**

It is this <u>Ith</u> day of <u>June</u>, 2013, by an affirmative vote of a quorum of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

**ORDERED** that the Order for Summary Suspension issued against the registration to practice as a pharmacy technician held by Mr. Afridi, Registration No. T09087, is **VACATED**; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
