**SECOND ORDER OF MODIFICATION**

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy is in receipt of a second petition from James Cianos, License No. 09089, requesting modification of the terms of probation as set forth in the Consent Order of Reinstatement, dated December 10, 2007, and the subsequent Order of Modification dated February 3, 2009. The Consent Order provides that Mr. Cianos may petition for modification of the probationary terms after one (1) year of probation. Specifically, Mr. Cianos requests modification of the term requiring him to continue psychotherapy treatment on a monthly basis. Upon consideration of Mr. Cianos's request, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

**ORDER**

It is this 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2009, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

**ORDERED** that Mr. Cianos shall continue psychotherapy treatment by maintaining visits with his treating physician at least every other month and on an as-needed basis; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Mr. Cianos shall fully comply with his treatment regimen;

**ORDERED** that all of the other terms of the Order of Modification dated February 3, 2009 and the Consent Order dated December 10, 2007 remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
