**ORDER OF MODIFICATION**

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") is in receipt of a request from Drug Hut, Permit No. P07628, for modification of a certain condition contained in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated June 10, 2021. The Final Decision and Order issued a stayed suspension period of two (2) years against Drug Hut's permit during which time Drug Hut is required to abide by certain conditions, to include retaining a Board-approved peer consultant within 60 days. Drug Hut requests modification of the Order to delete this condition due to an anticipated sale of the pharmacy. Upon consideration of Drug Hut's request, the Board voted to modify the Final Decision and Order dated June 10, 2021, as set forth below.

**ORDER**

It is this 24 day of August 2021, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

**ORDERED** that the Final Decision and Order, dated June 10, 2021, be modified to stay the condition that Drug Hut retain a Board-approved peer consultant within 60 days of the Order, **PROVIDED THAT:**

1. Drug Hut immediately cease all ordering, dispensing and distributing of all Schedule II-V controlled dangerous substances;
2. Drug Hut appropriately transfers all existing controlled dangerous substances inventory to another DEA registrant or reverse distributor and provides documentation of such

transfers to the Board;


3. Drug Hut notifies all of its wholesale drug distributors that the pharmacy is not authorized to order controlled dangerous substances, and provides a copy of the notifications to the Board; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that in the event that Drug Hut wishes to commence dispensing of controlled dangerous substances, Drug Hut must first provide the Board with written notification and retain a Board-approved peer consultant in accordance with the terms of the Final Decision and Order, dated June 10, 2021; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that all other terms and conditions of the June 10, 2021, Final Decision and Order shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, General Provisions Article, Section 4-301.
