ORDER OF MODIFICATION

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") is in receipt of a petition from Kenneth C. Kruk, Pharmacist License No. 19723, requesting modification of certain terms of probation set forth in the Board's Final Consent Order, dated November 28, 2012. The Consent Order placed Dr. Kruk's pharmacist license on probation for a period of at least two (2) years based on substance abuse impairment. The Consent Order permits Dr. Kruk to petition the Board for modification of the probationary terms after one (1) year. Dr. Kruk is requesting that the Board discontinue his requirement to: (1) participate in weekly 12-step meetings, (2) submit to monthly urine screenings, (3) and provide quarterly reports from his employer. Upon consideration of Dr. Kruk's petition, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

ORDER

It is this <u>25</u> day of <u>Marsh</u>, 2014, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

ORDERED that the requirements of Probationary Term No. 6 contained in the Final Consent Order, dated November 28, 2012, are terminated, and that Dr. Kruk is no longer required to provide the Board with quarterly employer reports; and be it further,

ORDERED that all other terms of the November 28, 2012, Final Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
