CONSENT ORDER

Background

On or about December 23, 2022, Gweneth Markowski submitted a pharmacy technician renewal application to the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”), in accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-07(c). On her renewal application, Ms. Markowski answered “yes” to the question “Have you committed a criminal act for which you pled guilty or nolo contendere, or for which you were convicted or received probation before judgment?” Ms. Markowski provided an explanation and documentation showing that she received probation before judgment for 4th degree burglary on September 22, 2022.

In lieu of instituting formal proceedings against Ms. Markowski’s registration, in accordance with the Maryland Pharmacy Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 12-6B-01 *et seq.*, the Board has offered Ms. Markowski the opportunity to resolve this matter by agreeing to the terms set forth in this Consent Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ms. Markowski was initially registered as a pharmacy technician on October 23, 2019, under Registration No. T23101. Her registration is currently active and is set to expire on January 31, 2025.
2. On or about December 23, 2022, Ms. Markowski applied for renewal of her pharmacy technician registration.
3. On her renewal application, Ms. Markowski answered “yes” to the question “Have you committed a criminal act for which you pled guilty or nolo contendere, or for which you were convicted or received probation before judgment?” Ms. Markowski explained that she received six months of probation after pleading guilty to 4th degree burglary on September 22, 2022.
4. A review of the Maryland Judiciary Case Search confirmed the information provided by Ms. Markowski.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Ms. Markowski is subject to discipline pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 12-6B-02(b)(1) and 12-6B-09(22).

ORDER

Based on an affirmative vote of the Board, it is this 15th day of June, 2023, hereby:


ORDERED that upon the next renewal of Ms. Markowski’s pharmacy technician registration, she shall submit to a State criminal history records check; and be it further,

ORDERED that in the event Ms. Markowski's criminal history records check indicates further criminal activity, the Board may impose further disciplinary action against her registration, including suspension or revocation, after notice and an opportunity for a hearing; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Markowski shall be responsible for all costs associated with this Consent Order; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions § 4-333(b).
