

EXHIBIT A

VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF PHARMACIST'S LICENSE

I, James F. McManus, P.D., agree to voluntarily surrender my license to practice pharmacy in Maryland. I further agree that the terms of this agreement are to be considered public information and may be communicated to the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy's Clearinghouse and the boards of pharmacy of any other states in which I may be licensed as a pharmacist.

I further agree that the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy is not required to reinstate my license or reissue a new license unless I am able to demonstrate at a hearing before the Board that I do not present a danger to the public health, safety and welfare and that I am physically, mentally and professionally competent to practice pharmacy.
